### Road Contracts

Compared dust control companies. Central Minnesota will have west side of State Highway 25. Quality Propane Fountain Lake, Old Apostolic Church and east of State Highway 25.

Dust control on 108<sup>th</sup> Street from Clementa to State Highway 25 will be added to the regularly scheduled dust-controlled roads in 2026 done by the township. Motion Made by Young and Pawelk. Motion Carried.

Bjorklund Companies hauling of gravel. Bjorklund can add about 1,000 yards to the current contract. 108<sup>th</sup> Street will be added to the list of roads that Bjorklund will haul gravel on this summer. Fillmore Avenue south of 85<sup>th</sup> Street to County Road 30 is also a tentative for Bjorklund Companies. This will be roughly 5,000 yards of gravel total for Bjorklund Companies to haul.

MMS for Bjorklund Companies to haul 5000 yards by Pawelk and Young. MCU

Ditch Cleaning: Will be split between MSB Excavating and Matter Excavating. There are two ditches that will be cleaned this spring. One on Ferman Avenue, additionally 105<sup>th</sup> Street. 70<sup>th</sup> Street should also be completed, but it will need to be put on trucks.

### Compensation

MMS by Pawelk and Young to change the meeting pay to \$140/meeting. MCU.

MMS to increase the clerk's hours to 40 hours a month and increase the pay to \$47/hour by Pawelk and Young. MCU.

MMS to increase the treasurer's hourly pay to \$47/hour by Pawelk and Young. MCU.

Election judges will stay at \$25/hour for 2026 elections. MMS to add one meal per shift for election judges by Pawelk and Young. MCU

### Resident Charges

The following changes were made to Charges to Woodland Residents. Grader including driver will increase to \$250 per hour. Hauling gravel with the truck will increase to \$275 per load. Truck and Pup will be \$400 per load. Payloader with driver will also be \$250 per hour. Clerk will charge \$47/ hour for printed Minutes. The remainder of the charges will stay the same for 2026.

MMS to approve the increases for township residents. MCU.
